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Executive Summary

The Survey among New Wikipedia Users includes 656 participants that mostly live in the Netherlands and Germany (respectively 332 and 281). The average respondent to this survey is male, 55 years old and highly educated.

Most of the participants (n=599) are only readers of Wikipedia articles, i.e. they have never written/edited any content and only few contribute content to Wikipedia (i.e. author/editor, n=34) or have done so in the past (n=23).

The target group of the survey, namely New Wikipedia Users, turned out to be a very small subset of the complete dataset. Only 44 respondents indicated that they had been using Wikipedia for less than two years. Half of the respondents have been reading Wikipedia articles for more than five years. The subsets of the contributors and ex-contributors turned out to be too small to draw any conclusions concerning differences between new and older users.

With this survey we studied reasons for reading and contributing to Wikipedia. Out of this analysis we can arrive at several guidelines and recommendations for Wikimedia Chapters to activate and mobilize their readers and turn them into contributors.

The readers would be much likelier to contribute if

- they knew that there were specific topic areas that needed their help;
- it was made clear to them that other people would benefit from their efforts.

It is thus important to create awareness among the readers about the status of the provided knowledge and how the Wikipedia content is consumed and distributed.

The new users (having used Wikipedia for less than two years) currently do not know how to contribute and Wikimedia should create a better environment for the new users to overcome their hesitation to collaborate on the Internet. If those new users had someone to show them how to contribute to Wikipedia, they would be much likelier to start contributing. This is in line with the ex-contributors, who indicated that they would be much likelier to start contributing again, if the technology was easier to use.

1 Introduction

1.1 Overview of the Deliverable

After a short explanation of the purpose and background of this deliverable, we will explain the methods and limitation of the survey that was conducted.

Thereafter, we will present the results of the Survey among New Wikipedia Users. Starting with a short chapter on the socio-demographic features of our participants, we will elaborate on their reasons for contributing, non-contributing and – in some cases – stopping to contribute.

1.2 Connections to other Deliverables

Regarding impact analysis (SP5) and action research (SP4) we are dealing with three types of impacts that can clearly be distinguished:

- The impact of the Internet on the quality of life and social inclusion of seniors, which is captured by the surveys in SP5.
- The impact of our activating measures on the members of our community partners, which is captured by SP4.
- The impact of external organizations' measures to activate their members, which is captured by the context analysis in SP5.

The key outcome of the impact analysis should be an account of measures and effects that also includes a validation in terms of success and conditions under which these measures have been implemented.

This deliverable focuses on the impact of our activating measures on the members of our community partners, which is captured by SP4 and the impact of external organizations' measures (such as, in this case, Wikimedia Netherlands) to activate their members.

Where D5.1 and D5.2 focused on the social inclusion and well-being of older adults participating online, it was also shown that those people do not fully use the possibilities of Web 2.0, i.e. interaction, participation and contribution to online platforms and communities. With this deliverable the reasons behind these choices are researched. Furthermore, this deliverable follows up on D4.1, to see to what extent the exploration and multiplication phases of the Action Research are carried out (for example “Silver Knowledge”/ “Silverwissen”).

1.3 Value Added by the Project TAO

This online survey among new Wikipedia users on various Wikipedia language versions intended to measure the impact of methods for “mobilisation” and “inclusion & motivation” introduced on the German language version. Furthermore this study was used to analyse the effects of online measures implemented in order to facilitate the access of older adults to Wikimedia projects, taking into account

both the target group itself and younger age groups. The survey thus sheds a light on activities such as the “Silberwissen” project of Wikimedia Germany from a different perspective than that of the “Silberwissen” project itself.

2 Purpose and Background of the Survey

The TAO project aims to harness the growing reservoir of potentially active elderly people to boost social activity and collaboration in online communities. It provides existing online communities with the tools and methods to attract more senior citizens and endeavours to demonstrate how goal-oriented communities such as Wikipedia communities can profit from increased participation of older adults, thus setting off a “community pull” to encourage older adults to engage in social interactions on the Internet.

In order to assess the impact of selected methods for “mobilisation” and “inclusion & motivation”, developed in this project with regard to the achievement of the project’s foremost objectives (see above) and in order to provide supplements to the characteristics of the target public and the effectiveness of selected measures for “mobilisation” of SP4, the Survey Among New Wikipedia Users was realized. This deliverable presents Wikipedia users’ motives and reasons to contribute, not contribute or to stop contributing. The outcomes and conclusion of this deliverable can be used by Wikimedia Chapters in particular and online communities in general in order to streamline their actions about the participating and contributing target group and to facilitate their engagement.

3 Methods & limitations

3.1 Data

From the 15th of April until the 18th of May 2013, 656 respondents filled out the online questionnaire.

3.2 Administration

This survey was set up via the Web-Application 'Survey Monkey'¹. Survey languages were English, German and Dutch.

All TAO community partners and ZAWIW (because of their extensive database of senior online participants) were asked to distribute the surveys' URLs to their members and to their wider networks. It was intended that participants distributed the URLs further to their social networks in order to recruit a diverse sample via snowball-recruitment. For the Netherlands, Wikimedia NL was also involved in the recruitment process. Unfortunately, Seniorweb CH did not actively distribute the URLs.

3.3 Methods

The questionnaire was developed by the use of different sources. It was intended to rely on well-known and tested questionnaires and instruments as far as possible. The sociodemographic questions were mainly taken from the European Social Survey (ESS) data set². The ESS is a regularly repeated survey which is being carried out in 30 European countries, including the Netherlands and Germany. Using ESS questions has several advantages:

- It allows checking for the representativeness of our survey.
- It facilitates the questions' wording because one can use previously translated and tested questions in the different languages.
- It produces comparable results between the participating countries.

To analyse the research goal, the impact of methods for "mobilisation" and "inclusion & motivation", we were also able to use questions from the General Wikipedia Survey from 2008³, designed and conducted by UNU-MERIT, and added several new questions (see Annex A).

The complete survey was pre-tested by TAO's research partners, Wikimedia DE and NL and a small team of Wikimedia NL's employees and active volunteers. After testing, some minor amendments were implemented.

3.4 Limitations

A major limitation of the survey is the selection of participants. Due to our self-selection recruitment and the fact that the survey was targeting at New Wikipedia Users, potential participants might have chosen not to complete the survey. 803 participants indeed chose their language, but only 656 participants subsequently completed the survey. As with the data of our first and second wave surveys (see Deliverable 5.1 and 5.2.), most of the survey respondents are not active contributors to Wikipedia. Despite the recruitment via the Wikimedia Chapters of Germany and the Netherlands, most participants seem to come from the other communities involved. This led to 656 participants, out of which only 44 qualify as 'new' users (having used Wikipedia for less than two years). Wikipedia users have mostly been reading and using the website for a longer period of time. Even smaller groups of respondents indicated that they were contributors or ex-contributors. Therefore, for the new users' analysis, only the readers' subset is used.

Despite these limitations, the dataset proved interesting enough to generate some recommendations towards the Wikipedia Chapters on how to promote and increase (mobilize and activate) contributions from older adults to their platform.

4 Socio-demographics

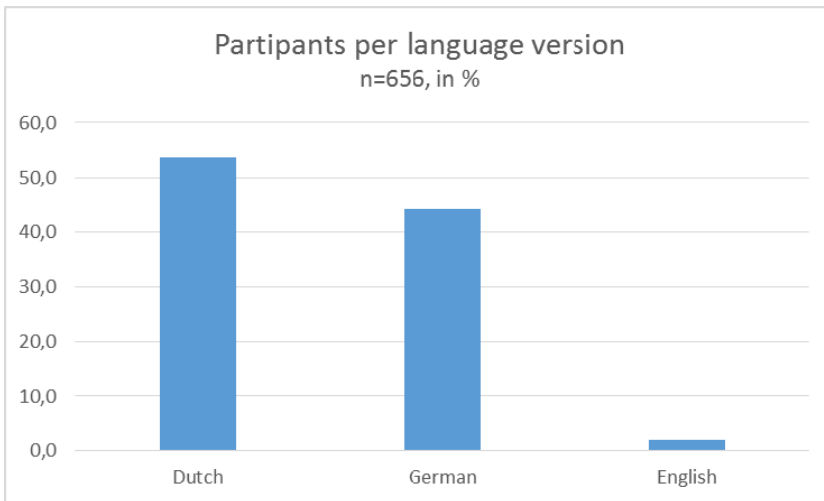


Figure 1: Participants per language version

With 430 participants, the share of the Dutch language version was the biggest (53.8%). The German version was used by 44.2% and 2.4% of the participants used the English version of the questionnaire (see Figure 1).

This does not mean that all participants are living in the Netherlands, Germany or the UK. However, most participants of the survey live in the Netherlands and Germany (respectively 332 and 281). The other 26 participants come from 9 other countries.

More males than females answered the questions of the survey, with 63% of the participants being male and 37% female (see Figure 3).

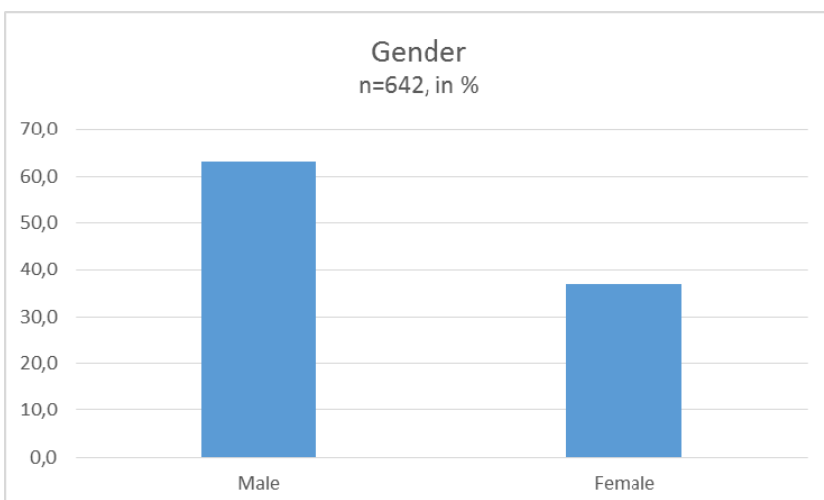


Figure 2: Gender

As most of the recruitment went via the TAO project’s community partners, the average age of the participants is also quite high with 66,9 years old (standard deviation: 16,4). Most participants of the survey fall into the category of senior citizens (55 years old and older) and only 4.7% are younger than 55 years (see Figure 4).

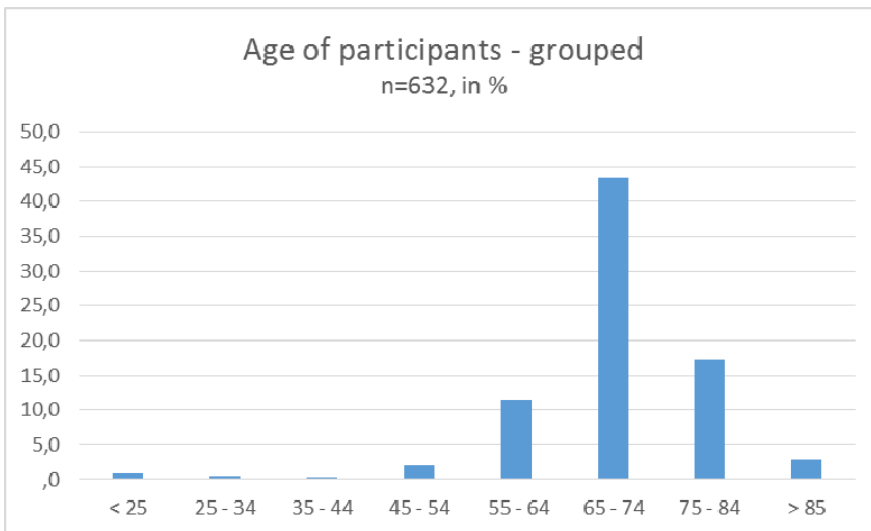


Figure 3: Age of participants - grouped

The educational level of the participants is high. 40% of the respondents indicated they finalized education at secondary level and 53% indicated a tertiary degree. From the remaining 7%, 2% and 5% finished primary education and quaternary education respectively (see Figure 5).

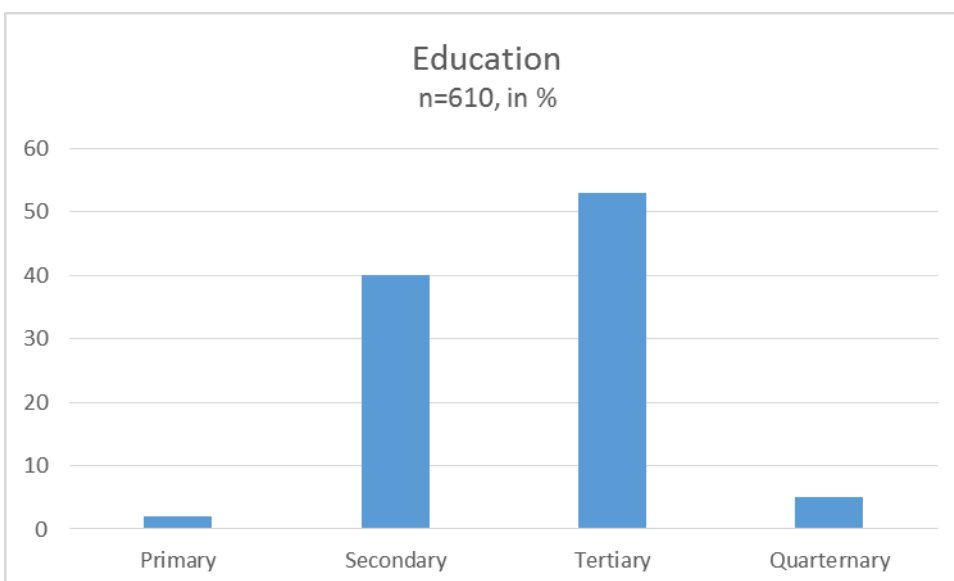


Figure 4: Education

In conclusion, about our participants, we can say that they are mostly male, with a high education, which is similar to the general Wikipedia community (see D5.1).

5 Interaction with Wikipedia

Our starting question, after the socio-demographic section, relates to the interaction with Wikipedia.

We asked our participants whether they are:

- only readers of Wikipedia articles, i.e. never wrote/edited any content;
- also contributors to Wikipedia content (i.e. author/editor);
- former contributors who stopped contributing and now only read.

91% of the participants stated that they only read Wikipedia, 5% of the respondents are also contributors and 4% are ex-contributors (see Figure 6).

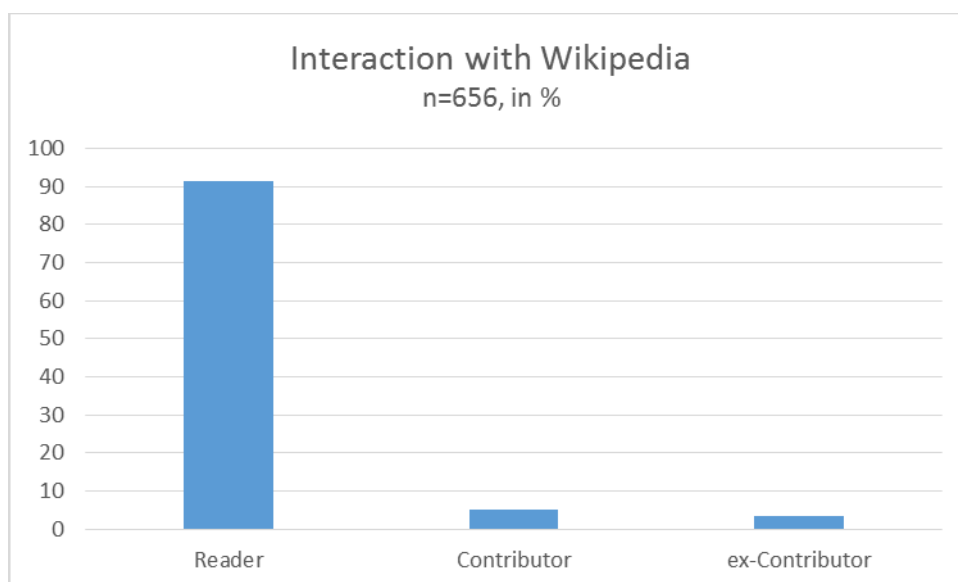


Figure 5: Interaction with Wikipedia

The following paragraphs elaborate on the questions that the readers (section 5.1) and contributors and ex-contributors (section 5.2) answered.

5.1 Readers

We asked for how long the readers had been using Wikipedia and quite a small group (of 44 respondents) indicated that they had been using Wikipedia for less than two years. Half of the respondents already have been reading Wikipedia articles for more than five years (see Figure 7).

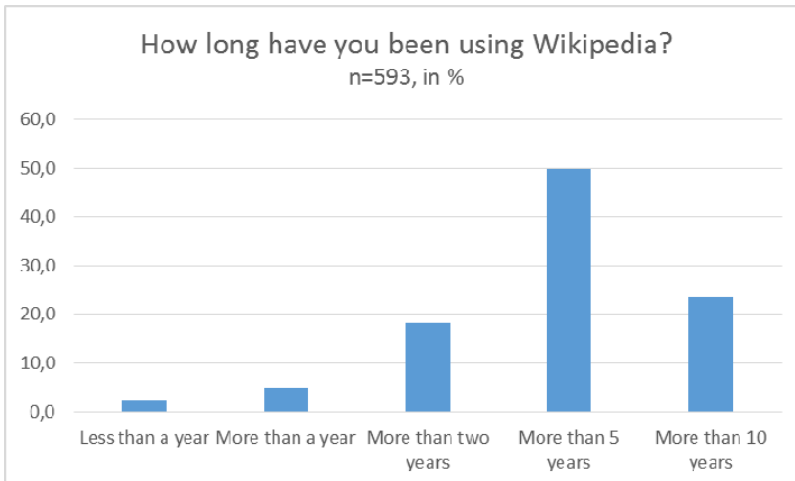


Figure 6: How long have you been using Wikipedia?

The 44 respondents having used Wikipedia for less than two years, are called New Users and will also be discussed in this paragraph. Since this is only a very small subset of the complete dataset, all survey questions of the complete dataset are analysed here and any significant differences in comparison to the New Users will be elaborated.

Almost 80% of the readers have never considered contributing to Wikipedia (see Figure 8). The readers who considered contribution will be discussed in the next paragraph (see section 5.1.1). The readers who have never considered to contribute to the collaborative encyclopedia are discussed thereafter (see section 5.1.2).

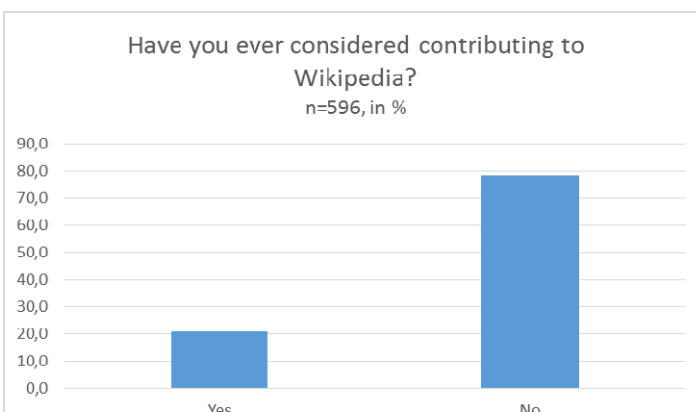


Figure 7: Have you ever considered contributing to Wikipedia?

5.1.1 Readers who considered contribution

In total, 126 respondents indicated that they considered to write or edit articles on Wikipedia. Among the New Users only 4 out of 44 respondents stated to consider contribution. Unfortunately this makes it impossible to check for significant differences between the dataset and the subset. The New Users will only be discussed in section 5.1.2.

The most important motives for not contributing are that they do not have any experience with online collaboration communities and that they are not sufficiently comfortable with the technology. Another frequently stated, but also more passive, reason is that they are happy just to read the articles on Wikipedia and do not have the urge to write any articles (see Figure 9).

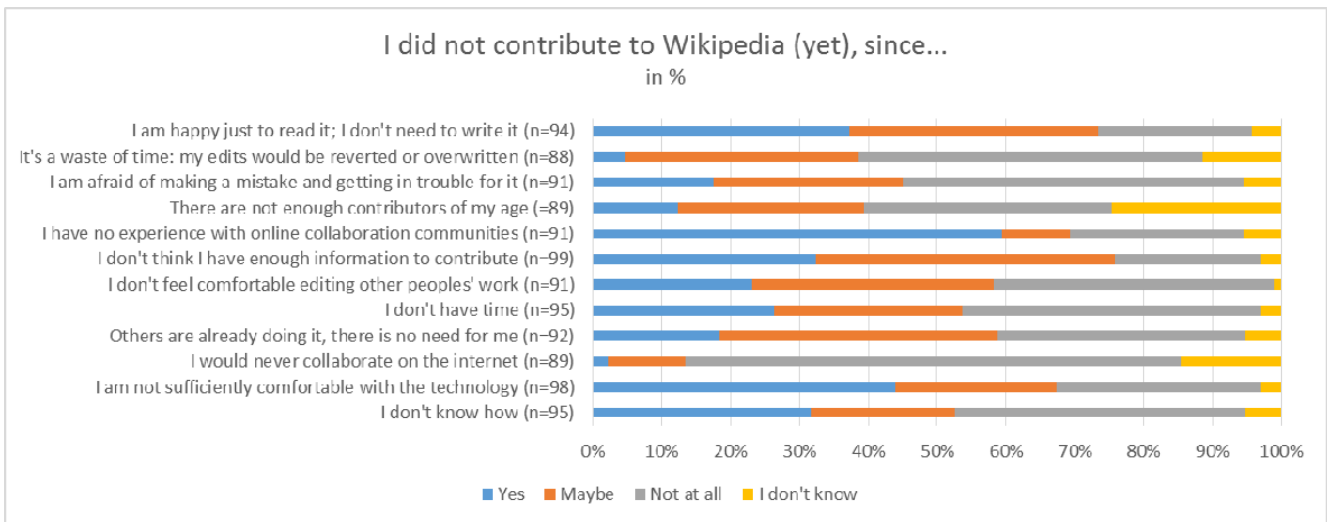


Figure 8: I did not contribute to Wikipedia (yet), since...

The respondents would be much likelier to contribute if they knew that there were specific topic areas that needed their help (62%) and if it was made clear to them that other people would benefit from their efforts (44%). Also one third of the respondents indicated that they would like to have someone to show them how to do it and that they would like to be informed that other contributors would be welcoming and encouraging about their contribution (see Figure 10).

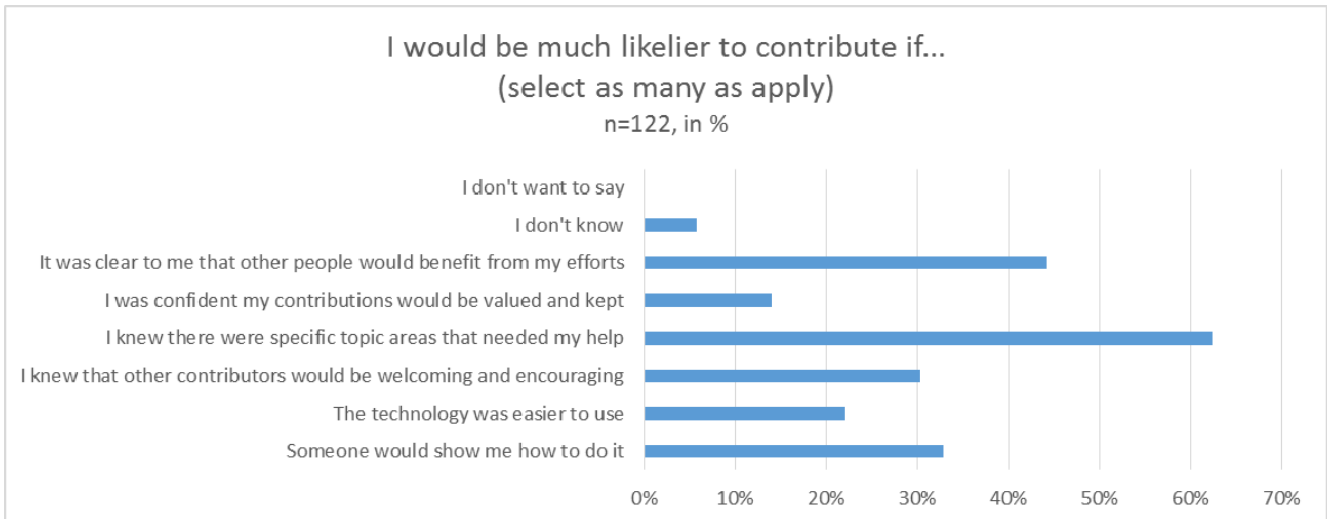


Figure 9: I would be much likelier to contribute if...

5.1.2 Readers who never considered contribution

The most frequent reason for not contributing given by the respondents who never considered contribution is that they are happy just to read and do not need to write. They do not hesitate to collaborate online or think to lack time to contribute. Other frequently chosen reasons are the lack of experience with online collaboration communities, the possible lack of information on contributing and the low level of comfort with the technology (see Figure 11).

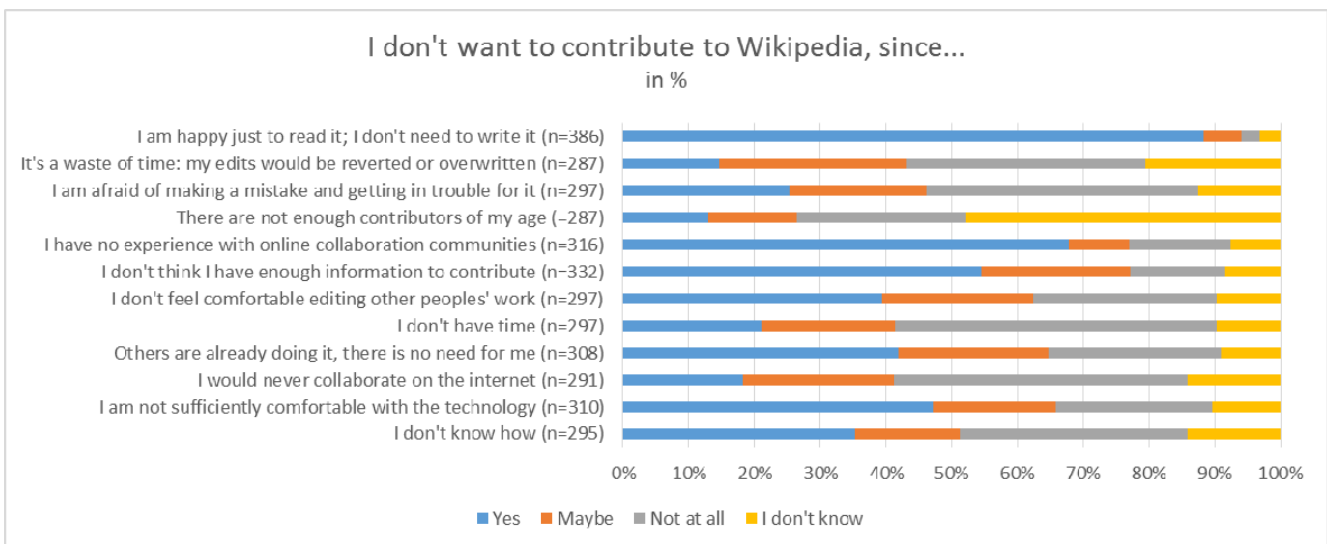


Figure 10: I don't want to contribute to Wikipedia, since...

Among the new users most of the answers to this question are similar. With the chi-square test we compared the empirical and the expected frequencies of answers for the two groups (new users vs. complete sample). Only two answers differ significantly, namely 'I don't know' and 'I would never collaborate on the Internet' (see Table 1).

A very big share of new users indicated that the fact that they do not know how to contribute is a reason for not contributing to Wikipedia, compared to the other users (see Table 2).

In this group of new users, there is apparently also a hesitation to collaborate on the Internet, as also a bigger group of new users stated that they would never collaborate online. Among the other users this is not a reason for not contributing to Wikipedia (see Table 3).

The respondents that stated never to have considered contributing to Wikipedia, also indicated that many of the motives to start contributing are not applicable to them. However, they stated that they would be much likelier to contribute, if it was clear to them that other people would benefit from their efforts and if they knew there were specific topic areas that needed their help (see Figure 12).

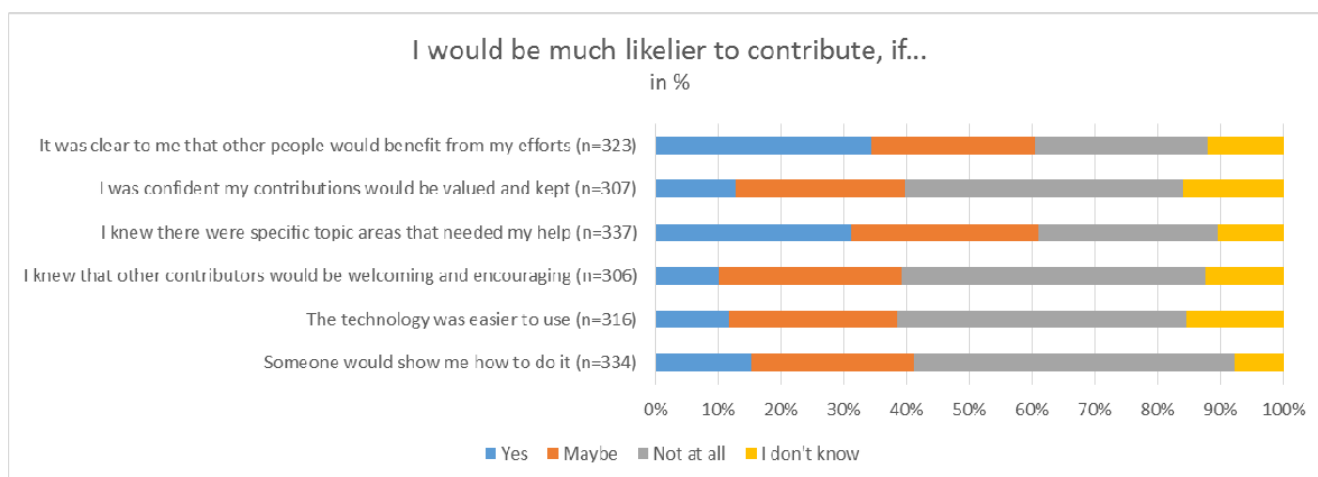


Figure 11: I would be much likelier to contribute, if...

Among these motives only the answer given to ‘Someone would show me how to do it’ gives a significant difference between the new users’ subset and the other respondents (see Table 4).

While most of the older users (using Wikipedia for more than two years) answered that they do not need someone to show them how to write and/or edit articles on Wikipedia, to start to contribute, more than one third of the new users indicated they would like to have someone to show them (see Table 5).

5.2 Contributors and ex-contributors

Only 34 participants of the survey stated that they are contributors and an additional 23 respondents indicated they used to be contributors (see Figure 6). It is hard to draw any conclusions from this small group, but we would like to present their answers in this chapter.

The contributors spend 8.6 hours per week on average contributing to the Wikipedia platform. This can be divided in – on average – 2.3 hours of research, 1.6 hours of writing and the major share of 4.8 hours of editing Wikipedia content (see Table 6).

For the contributors, the most important reason for contributing to Wikipedia is that they like the idea of sharing knowledge and want to contribute to it. Furthermore, other important reasons include that they think that information should be freely available to everyone, that they saw errors in an article they wanted to fix and that they like Wikipedia's philosophy of openness and collaboration (see Figure 13).

The ex-contributors show a different pattern of reasons why they used to contribute to Wikipedia. Their most important reasons are that they also like the idea of sharing knowledge and want to contribute to it and that they think that information should be freely available to everyone. One reason that stands out among the ex-contributors is that some of them wanted to make topics more popular that are not widely known yet (see Figure 13).

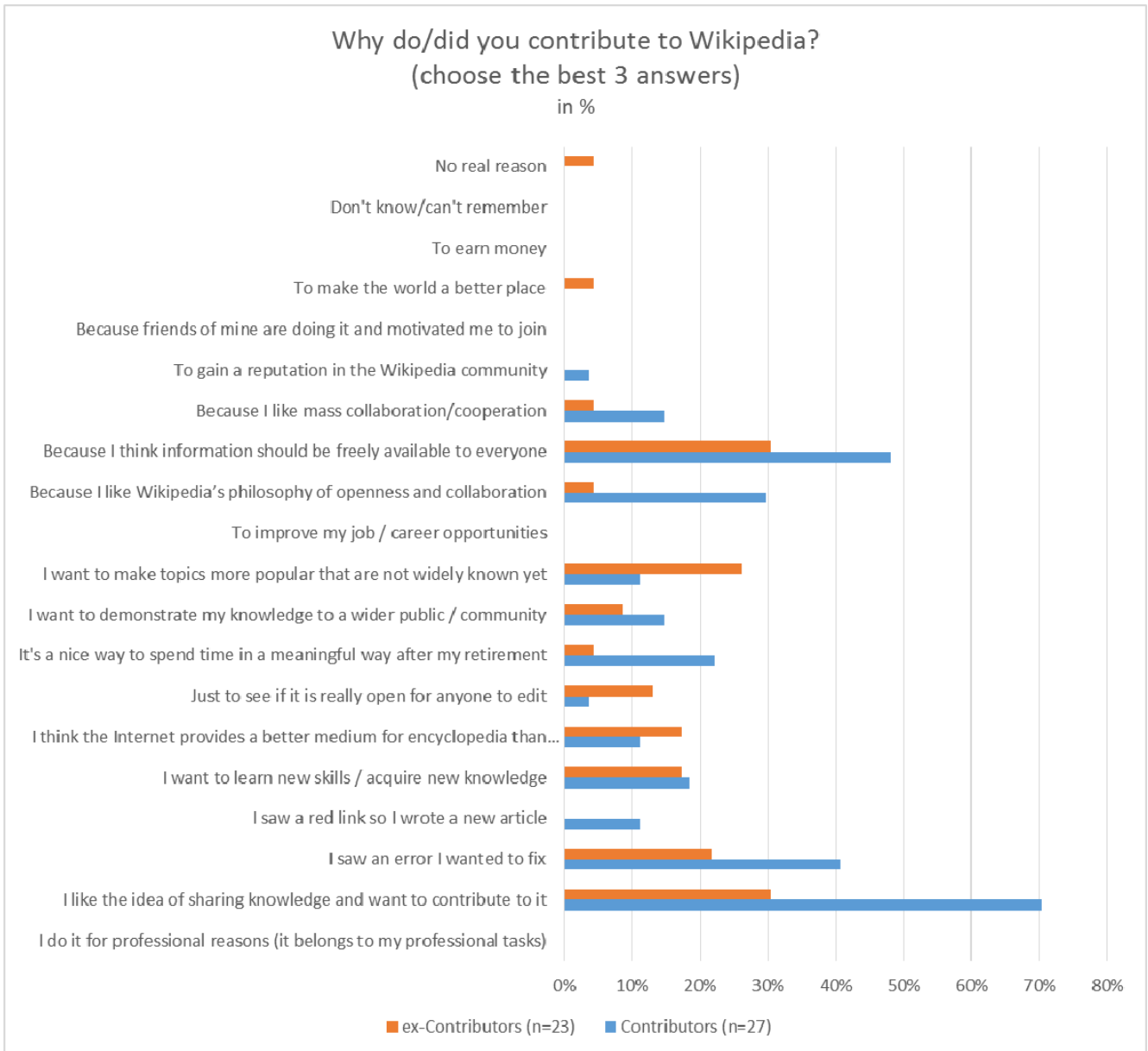


Figure 12: Why do/did you contribute to Wikipedia?

The most important reasons for the ex-contributors to stop contributing to Wikipedia are the lack of time and the lack of information to contribute. Nevertheless, 12% of the respondents to this question also indicated that contributing caused distress and that they were demotivated by the community (see Figure 14).

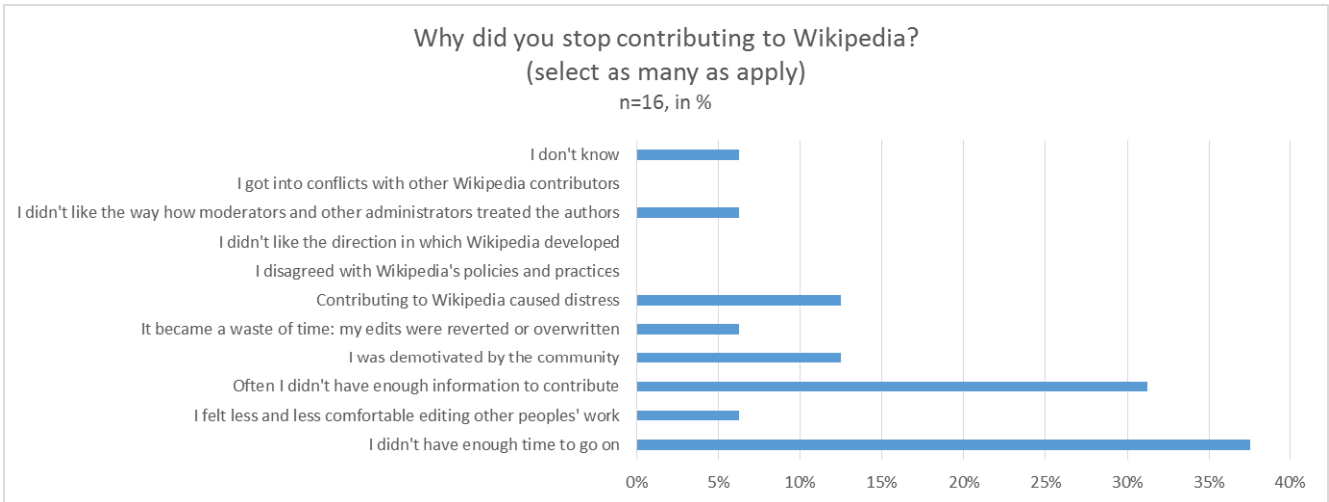


Figure 13: Why did you stop contributing to Wikipedia?

Despite these possible problems in the community making them stop contributing, most of the respondents indicated that they would be much likelier to start contributing again, if the technology was easier to use. The ex-contributors answered that the value of their contributions and specific topic areas lacking contribution are no reasons enough to start writing or editing articles again (see Figure 15).

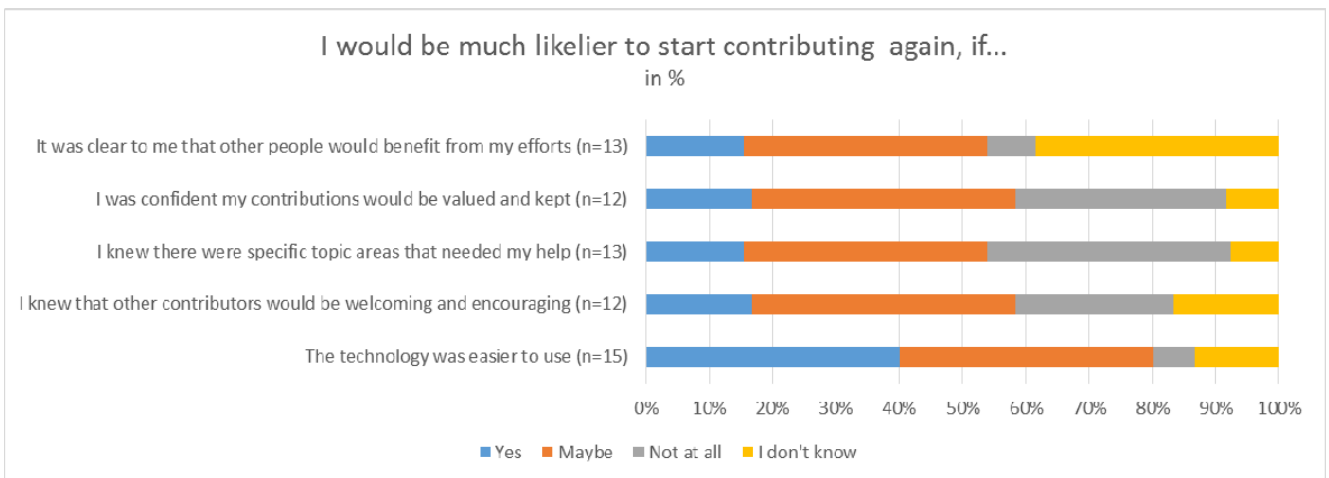


Figure 14: I would be much likelier to start contributing again, if...

6 Workshops

To activate and mobilize more people to contribute to Wikipedia, workshops and courses could be organized. The last questions of the survey addressed these matters. We asked our respondents in which form they would prefer to have these workshops and/or courses.

There were several options to choose from, namely either online or offline (face-to-face) courses both either individual or with others. With the exception of the offline individual course, the respondents indicated all other options would suit them well. With 34% there is preference for the online individual course, but the online and offline course with others follow shortly with 30% and 27% respectively (see Figure 16).

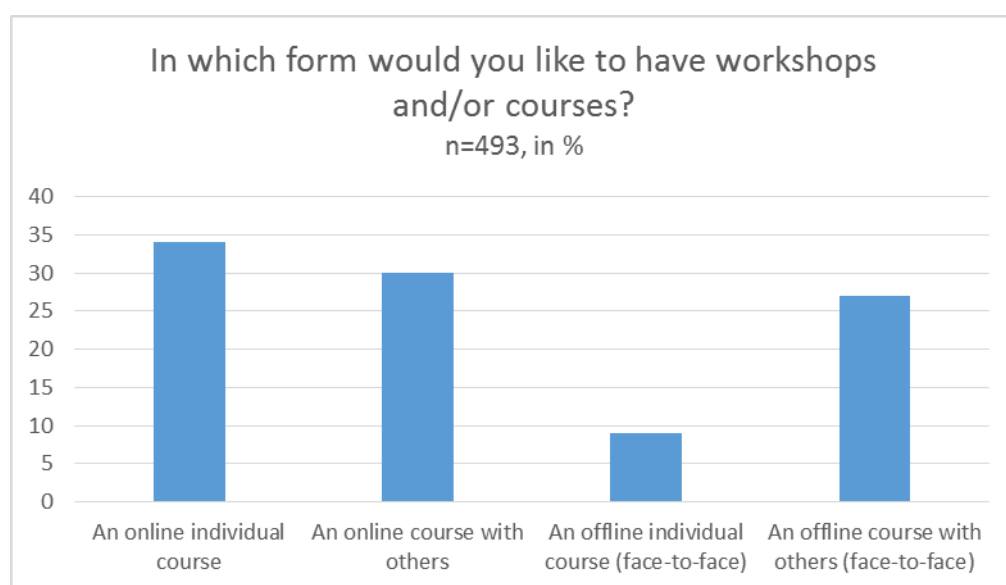


Figure 15: In which form would you like to have workshops and/or courses?

When asking for the preferred organization that should organize these workshops and/or courses, the majority of the respondents (62%) stated that they would like to see their national Wikimedia Chapter to set this up. Only 24% indicated an organization that is experienced in giving ICT courses as an answer to this question and 7% named other organization or were unsure which organization, as showed in their open reactions to this question (see Figure 17).

Half of the Dutch participants that indicated an organization that is experienced in giving ICT courses also stated that they would like to have SeniorWeb to organize these workshops and/or courses. This might be biased because of the recruitment via SeniorWeb. The same can be said about the German respondents who indicated an organization that is experienced in giving ICT courses with University

of Ulm/ZAWIW/ViLE-network (8 respondents). Some others also agreed that this could be a task for the community college (Volkshochschule, 7 respondents).

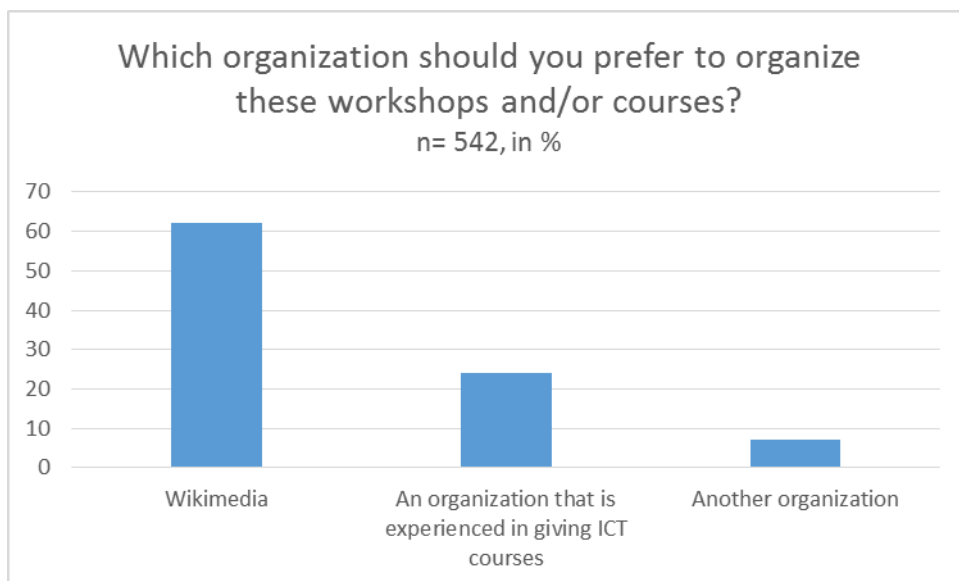


Figure 16: Which organization should you prefer to organize these workshops and/or courses?

7 Conclusions

Most of the respondents (599 participants) stated that they only read Wikipedia and within this group only 44 participants could be attributed to the New Wikipedia Users subgroup (having used Wikipedia for less than two years).

It is interesting to see that those Wikipedia readers who considered contributing to Wikipedia, indicated a lack of online collaborative experience and a lack of comfort with the technology as reasons for their choices. The readers who did not consider to contribute to Wikipedia, indicated that they are happy just to read and do not need to write, which is also still an important reason among the readers who are more inclined to contribute.

All readers, hence both groups, would be likelier to contribute if especially they knew that there were specific topic areas that needed their help and that it was made clear to them that other people would benefit from their efforts. A better feedback loop could be introduced for contributors to make the contributing experience from them more rewarding.

The New Users group shows a slightly different answering pattern. A very big share of new users indicated that they do not know how to contribute and they also displayed a greater degree of general reluctance to collaborate on the Internet. The new users indicated that they would like to have someone to show them how to contribute to Wikipedia, in order to possibly start contributing and feel more confident.

Only 34 participants of the survey stated that they are contributors and an additional 23 respondents indicated they used to be contributors. The contributors spend 8.6 hours per week on average contributing to the Wikipedia platform. This can be divided in – on average – 2.3 hours of research, 1.6 hours of writing and the major share of 4.8 hours of editing Wikipedia content.

The most important reason for contributing to Wikipedia is that they like the idea of sharing knowledge and want to contribute to it. One reason that stands out among the ex-contributors is that some of them wanted to make topics more popular, which are not yet widely known.

The most important reasons for the ex-contributors to stop contributing to Wikipedia are the lack of time and the lack of information to contribute. Most of these respondents also indicated that they would be much likelier to start contributing again, if the technology was easier to use.

The respondents of the survey among New Wikipedia Users indicated that they would prefer workshops to be organized by the national Wikimedia Chapter. Concerning the format, i.e., either online or offline with others or individually online, there is no consensus.

With this survey we studied reasons for reading and contributing to Wikipedia. Out of this analysis we can come to several guidelines and recommendations for Wikimedia Chapters to activate and mobilize their readers into contributors.

The readers would be much likelier to contribute if

- they knew that there were specific topic areas that needed their help;
- it was made clear to them that other people would benefit from their efforts.

It is thus important to create awareness among the readers about the status of the provided knowledge and how the Wikipedia content is consumed and distributed.

The new users (using Wikipedia less than two years) currently do not know how to contribute and Wikimedia should create a better environment for the new users to overcome their refusal to collaborate on the internet. In case those new users have someone to show them how to contribute to Wikipedia, they would be much likelier to start contributing. This is in line with the ex-contributors, who indicated that they would be much likelier to start contributing again, if the technology was easier to use.
